

BVWS Music Department Opening, 2019-2020 School Year

Boulder Valley Waldorf School, a K-8 independent school in Niwot, Colorado is seeking a dynamic cello teacher for the 2019-2020 school year to join our music faculty. BVWS music program includes choir, violin, cello and band. The cello teaching position includes leading approximately 9-13 classes per week at \$31.75 per class for 3rd through 8th graders. There is additional income for other school duties (recess, closing and meeting time.) Space for teaching private lessons is also available on campus after school.

Founded in 1993, BVWS is a Pre-KG through Eighth Grade independent not-for-profit school. We offer a full Waldorf curriculum, including two world languages, woodworking, handwork, movement, instrumental and orchestral music, and chorus. Located in Niwot, Colorado, midway between Boulder and Longmont, our school is set on a five-acre campus within 38 acres of school-owned agricultural land and features stunning views of the Rocky Mountains. This setting provides a wonderful rural atmosphere for festivals and community life, and sustains an enthusiastic community of experienced teachers, devoted, hard-working parents, and a healthy, energetic student body. The region is an ideal mix of rural and urban, with farms and extensive open space giving way in one direction to the vibrant college town of Boulder and in the other direction to Longmont, rated one of the best places to live in the US. The region offers world-class year-round outdoor recreation opportunities and is connected to the world by Denver International Airport, rated best large airport in the US.

In addition to Anthroposophical communities in Boulder and Denver, the Colorado Front Range area supports five Waldorf elementary schools, three Waldorf high schools (two of which are nearby in Boulder), several independent Waldorf kindergartens and numerous Waldorf home and day groups, plus a variety of Anthroposophical study groups and initiatives.
